




#### Diffused

Lens surface: Clear glass




#### Lens surface: Translucent glass



# Direct horizontal illuminance (1/2 illuminance angle: left side)






### Diffused (unit: lx)







# Safety Precautions

- Turn power off before working on the EF1A, otherwise explosion, fire hazard, or electric shocks may result.
- Special expertise is required to install, operate, maintain, and inspect the EF1A. People without such expertise must not use the EF1A, otherwise it may cause damage to equipment or serious accidents.
- Do not disassemble, repair, or modify the product. Otherwise electric shock, fire, or malfunction may occur.
- Do not damage the lighting equipment. Contact with damaged lighting equipment may lead to damages or serious accidents.
- Be sure to ground the terminals. Otherwise, electrical shock, fire, or explosion may occur.
- When using the product, be sure to read this catalog or instruction manuals.
- This product cannot be installed in zones 0 and 20.

- When wiring, use a wire size appropriate for the applied voltage and current
- Use heat-resistant wires of 75°C or more.
- Tighten the terminal screws (screw terminal type only) with the appropriate tightening torque. Incomplete wiring may cause abnormal heat generation, which may result in fire or explosion.
- Do not open the cover while the power is on. Failure to do so may result in electric shock, fire or explosion.
- When performing maintenance or inspection, be sure to turn off the power and do not open the cover for two minutes after power off.

#### Instructions

#### Precautions for use

- Be sure to observe the operating voltage range. Failure to do so may result in the destruction of the lighting equipment.
- Ensure correct operating temperature. Operating temperature is the ambient temperature where the product will be used. Temperature exceeding the specified value may cause rise in internal temperature and cause damage to the unit.
- Do not use or store the product in a place subject to vibration or shock. Otherwise, malfunctions may occur.

#### Installation location

- (1) Use the product in an operating temperature range of -20°C to +50°C. When the surface temperature may exceed +50°C due to direct sunlight, provide a shade to keep the surface temperature under +50°C.
- (2) Do not use in the following locations:
  - ① Exposed to direct sunlight, near heaters, high temperatures.
  - 2 Locations that may be exposed to chemicals or corrosive gases.
  - 3 Locations with high humidity.
  - ④ Subject to condensation or freezing, such as cold storage warehouse or air cooler outlet (make sure that condensation or freezing do not occur).

#### Installation

- (1) For direct mounting, fasten with four M6 bolts. For mounting bracket type, use M8 bolts or a method of equivalent strength. The thickness of the mounting bracket is 3 mm. (Refer to the dimensions.) The recommended tightening torque is M6: 3.9 to 5.4 N·m, M8: 10 to 13.5 N·m.
- (2) If the mounting bolts may loosen due to vibration, use a spring washer to prevent loosening.

### Installing/removing the cover

- (1) When removing the cover, use a hexagon wrench (size: 5) supplied with the EF1A to remove the cover bolts (hex socket head cap bolt). Do not lose the end cover bolts. Hex socket head cap bolts made of stainless steel (M6x18, with spring washer and plain washer) are used.
- (2) The cover is inserted into the housing. When installing or removing the cover, make sure that the cover is inserted or removed horizontally.
- (3) When installing the cover, observe the following:
  - No foreign objects on the gasket or on joint surface.
  - The gasket is in place.
  - The wires are not caught between the joint surfaces.
  - Install the cover slowly and tighten screws securely to a torque of 3.9 to 5.4 N·m.

(Note:) Check whether the bolts are tightened securely.



Note: Do not connect more than two wires to one terminal. When connecting an insulated wire to the terminal block, use a crimping terminal with insulation sheath. Bare crimping terminal must be insulated with an insulation tube or marking tube.

Make sure not to apply excessive force to the terminal block when installing the end cover.



### Instructions

#### **Protective grounding**

- Ground the EF1A according to the environment and ratings of the application where the EF1A is used. Observe the standards and regulations in each country and region.
- Use the M4 grounding terminal inside and make sure that the ground resistance value is under  $100\Omega$ .
- In wire wiring, use one core as grounding wire to connect to the grounding terminal.
- When not using the M4 grounding terminal inside, use the external M4 grounding terminal.
- Recommended tightening torque (M4): 1.4 to 2.0 N·m
- Use a wire in size and material which is durable against the maximum grounding current expected. Properly protect the ground wire from external damage.



## Warranty

- The warranty period is one year after delivery to the specified location.
- \*Exceptions to warranty coverage

  The warranty period is reduced to six (6) months if the product is run
  continuously over 20 hours.
- In the event of a failure caused by our responsibility within the above period, we will replace the product free of charge at the place where the product was purchased or delivered.
- \* Does not include expenses required for mounting, replacing, or installation work.
- The warranty does not apply if the product is used outside of the conditions described in the instruction manual and specification

- LED lighting have a product life.
- Because internal elements deteriorate after 8 to 10 years of installation even if they have no defects in appearance, inspection and/or replacement are recommended. Operation condition: temperature 30°C, 3,000-hour operation per year (10 hours per day). (JIS C 8105-1)
- Product life is shortened under high operating temperature or when it is lit for long hours.
- Inspection by contractors is recommended every 3 years.
